### Instructor

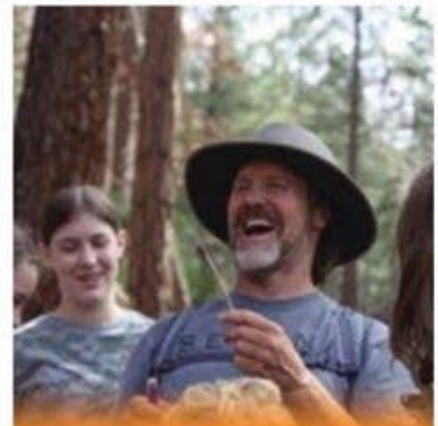

I separated honorably in 1988 and launched Wilderness Way Adventures, a faith-based outdoor ministry specializing in wilderness survival, bushcraft, and search and rescue training. I was also recently blessed when the History Channel called and asked if I would film myself surviving on Vancouver Island for Alone Season 2. It was a once-in-a-lifetime thrill!

It has been my privilege for the last 30 years to fly here and there throughout North America showing men, women, and children from all walks of life how to survive in their neck of the woods.
